

**LSU vs. Arizona**  
**Sept. 9, 2006 - Tiger Stadium (Baton Rouge, La.)**  
**Game Notes**

**Team Notes**

1. LSU's game captains were 16 **Craig Steltz**, 18 **Jacob Hester**, 41 **Chris Jackson** and 72 **Glenn Dorsey**.
2. LSU won the toss and deferred to the second half. Arizona received the opening kickoff.
3. Tigers extending their consecutive starts streak today were: FS **LaRon Landry** (37), CB **Chevis Jackson** (15), RT **Brian Johnson** (11), DE **Chase Pittman** (8).
4. First-time starters for LSU were RT **Marlon Favorite** and 82 **Richard Dickson**.
5. First-time players in tonight's game: 83 **Kyle Anderson**
6. LSU has now not been stopped by an opponent or missed a kick in 34 straight trips into the red zone. The streak dates back to the Auburn game in 2005 (26 touchdowns and eight field goals). LSU scored two touchdowns and kicked one field goal tonight.
7. **Jonathan Zenon's** interception return for a touchdown in the first quarter marked the first time LSU returned an interception for a score in consecutive games since the 2003 SEC Championship game (Lionel Turner) and the 2004 Sugar Bowl (Marcus Spears).
8. LSU extended its streak of holding its opponents to no offensive touchdowns to 14 consecutive quarters. The last time an opponent scored a touchdown against the Tigers was Georgia in the second quarter of the 2005 SEC Championship game.
9. LSU has now outscored its opponents 130-9 in the last 11 quarters of football. The streak includes a 40-3 victory over Miami in the 2005 Chick-fil-A Peach Bowl, a 45-3 win last week over UL-Lafayette and the 45-3 score tonight.
10. Tonight's attendance of 92,221 is the fifth largest crowd in Tiger Stadium history and the second largest non-conference crowd.
11. LSU's three interceptions tonight marks the first time the Tigers have recorded three picks in a game since the Troy game on Oct. 23, 2004.
12. With the victory, LSU extended its winning streak over Pac-10 opponents to nine straight games.
13. LSU has now won seven straight games in Tiger Stadium.
14. Not allowing a touchdown for the second straight week, it marks the first time since the 1987 season LSU has not allowed a touchdown in the first two games of the season.

**Individual Notes**

15. LB **Darry Beckwith** recorded the first sack of his career with 12:25 left in the first quarter.
16. PK **Colt David** connected on the fifth FG of his career with 9:17 left in the first quarter. David's kick was good from 21 yards out. He is now 5-6 in his career.
  - a. With six PATs tonight, PK **Colt David** has extended his consecutive successful PAT streak to 47 straight. The streak ties him with John Corbello as the third longest in school history.
17. CB **Jonathan Zenon** returned an interception 41 yards for a touchdown with 7:44 left in the first quarter.
  - a. The interception by **Zenon** is his third of the season and the second returned for a touchdown.
  - b. **Zenon** became the first LSU player to return two interceptions for TDs in one season since Jack Hunt accomplished the feat in 2003 with one against Louisiana Tech and one against UL-Monroe.
18. LB **Jacob Cutrera** fell on the first fumble recovery of his career with 7:31 left to go in the first quarter.
19. QB **JaMarcus Russell** tossed the 28<sup>th</sup> touchdown of his career with 6:17 left in the first quarter. He threw a five-yard pass to **Jacob Hester**.
  - a. **Russell** tossed the 29<sup>th</sup> touchdown of his career with 5:05 left in the third quarter. He tossed a 29-yard pass to **Dwayne Bowe**.
  - b. **Russell** is now tied for sixth-place with Rohan Davey on LSU's career touchdown list with 29.
  - c. **Russell** connected with **Bowe** on a touchdown pass for the 14<sup>th</sup> time in the pairs' career, moving the duo into a tie for third-place in LSU history for pass-catch combo touchdowns with Tommy Hodson-Tony Moss and Matt Mauck-Devery Henderson.
  - d. Connecting on 13-of-20 passes for 196 yards tonight, **Russell** moved into eighth-place on LSU's career passing yards (3,945), career completions (287) and career attempts (492) lists.
20. RB **Jacob Hester** pulled in the fourth receiving touchdown of his career on a five-yard pass from JaMarcus Russell with 6:17 left in the first quarter.
  - a. **Hester** scored his second rushing touchdown of the season and fourth of his career on a 28-yard run with 7:06 left in the third quarter.
  - b. **Hester's** six receptions for 53 yards are a career high for the junior.
21. WR **Craig Davis** pulled in a 14-yard reception with 3:03 left in the second quarter to extend his consecutive games with a reception streak to 25 (every game in which he has played).
22. RB **Alley Broussard** scored the 16<sup>th</sup> rushing touchdown of his career on a 17-yard run with 14:05 left in the second quarter.
23. With a tackle in the first half, SS **Jessie Daniels** extended his tackles in consecutive games streak. The senior has now made a tackle in 31 straight games.
24. With a tackle in the second half, FS **LaRon Landry** extended his tackles in consecutive games streak. The senior has now made a tackle in 41 straight games.
  - a. **Landry** pulled down the 10<sup>th</sup> interception of his career with 5:30 left in the third quarter.
25. WR **Dwayne Bowe** pulled down the 16<sup>th</sup> receiving touchdown of his career on a 29-yard pass from JaMarcus Russell with 5:05 left in the third quarter. The 16 touchdowns moves Bowe into a tie for seventh on LSU's career list with Tony Moss.
26. S **Craig Steltz** recorded the second interception of his career with 12 minutes left in the fourth quarter.
27. RB **Charles Scott** scored his first career touchdown with 7:22 in the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter on a 38-yard run.
